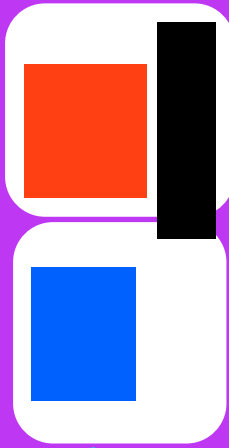

Stacey: "Thank you for all of your help, I will miss you, I love you!"

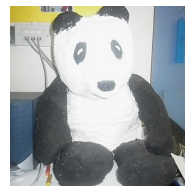
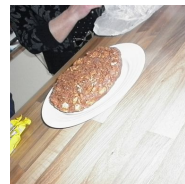
Callum: "Remember us!"
